Solon Chabad Hebrew School Pandemic Protocols

Solon Chabad adheres to all mandatory requirements from the CDC as well as many of the suggested practices. Following these rules can mitigate the risks but it does not eliminate the risk of COVID-19.

Drop Off/Pick Up

 All drop off and pick up will be done curbside. Parents are asked not to enter the building unless absolutely necessary.

Illness

- We will be taking the temperature of every staff & worker before they enter the building with a Non Contact Thermometer. Students will be asked to remain in their car until their temperature is taken. Anyone that has a temperature of 100 or more will be asked to go home.
- If a child or teacher tests positive for COVID19, that class will be closed for the next 14 days.
- If a child or staff has close contact with someone that tests positive for Covid-19, then they will need to be quarantined for 14 days.

Masks

 Staff & students must wear face coverings- we will have extra available if necessary

Sanitization

 We hired an extra cleaner who will be constantly sanitizing bathrooms and other high touch areas, such as door knobs throughout the day

Distancing:

- Each class will be in groups of 9 students and they will be assigned their own designated space inside and outside and will not mix with other classes. They will spend time outside <u>as much as possible</u>, weather permitting. When indoors, the windows will be open, creating an "Open Air Classroom" Students should come dressed appropriately.
- Each child will have his/her own assigned seat, supply boxes and are asked NOT to bring anything from home.

Food

 There will be no bagels for breakfast this year, but we will provide prepackaged snacks & fruits mid morning and staff will use gloves and masks when distributing.

Hand Washing

Staff and students must follow rigorous handwashing procedures as detailed by Ohio Law.

- Arrival of the day
- After using the restroom
- After outdoor play
- When visibly soiled
- Prior to departure
- Before eating and after eating
