FAQ'S (Frequently Asked Questions)

#1: Do I have to "belong" to Solon Chabad?

NO, the majority of our Hebrew School families are not members.

#2: What affiliation are most of the students?

Our hebrew school student body is made up of a mixture of Conservative Reform, unaffiliated and intermarried families.

#3: Is it important to start in Kindergarten?

When the "Holiday season" comes around, Kindergarten children who don't attend Sunday School often feel sad and left out. Our program will give them a sense of identity and belonging, as they celebrate all the Jewish holidays with their classmates.

We start the Kindergarten class in October, giving them a month to acclimate themselves to their public school class before beginning with Sunday School.

#4: Do you do Bar and Bat Mitzvahs?

Yes, we offer full Bar and Bat Mitzvah programs which result in meaningful ceremonies in our beautiful sanctuary, but if you prefer, we can assist in preparing your child for their Bar or Bat mitzvah in the Temple of your choice.

#5: What's unique about your school?

The students actually ENJOY coming since our young enthusiastic teachers use a non traditional classroom setting (no desks, textbooks etc) - just hands on activities and discussions to make the lessons come alive.

Grades 3-7 attend on Sunday mornings, 9:15- 12 pm and Wednesday afternoons from 4:00- 5:30 pm.
